



Venue Policies Center for Performing Arts

We are thrilled to be hosting our 2019 Chicago, IL event at the wonderful Center for Performing Arts at Governors State University once again!

Here's an important reminder regarding the venue's policies & parking.

1. **NO food or beverages of any kind are allowed inside the THEATER, including the staging & seating areas.**
2. **Outside food & beverages are permitted everywhere else in the building.**
3. The onsite concession stand will be selling various food items, such as hot dogs, chips, candies, nuts, cookies, water, soda, juice, coffee, root beer floats, & frozen yogurt smoothies. The stand also has assorted delivery & take out menus for various food items, such as sandwiches, salads, pizza, pasta, & burgers.
4. By state law, the entire campus of Governors State University is smoke-free, including outdoors. **Smoking is not permitted at all on campus.**
5. **All GSU parking lots are free** of charge and available to visitors and guests with the exception of Prairie Place and other designated parking areas. The closest parking lots to the Center for Performing Arts are West Lot 1 and East Lot 1.
