Here's an important reminder regarding the venue's food policies & parking.

1. **No outside food or beverages are allowed inside the venue.** An onsite caterer will be selling various food items.
2. **Each dancer may bring an empty water bottle to fill up at the water fountain.** The caterer will also be selling bottled water at the venue.
3. The City of Davenport has three conveniently located parking ramps in the downtown area. **Detailed parking information** is on the next page as well as the event page of our website:

For Studios Bringing Prop Trucks:

Parking is not guaranteed to be available for larger trucks. The ramps and surrounding street spaces will fill up quickly, so please arrive early to ensure there is enough space for you.

DOWNTOWN DAVENPORT, IOWA, PARKING INFORMATION

PARKING RAMPS: The City of Davenport has three conveniently located parking ramps in the downtown area: RiverCenter Ramp, Harrison Ramp and Redstone Ramp. All three parking ramps are enforced 24/7 and all parking is pre-pay only. There are two options to pay for parking in the ramps: visit one of the conveniently located pay stations or download the free Parkmobile App. The parking rates are as follows:

- \$1.00 for 2 hours
- \$2.00 for 4 hours
- \$3.00 for 6 hours
- \$4.00 for 8 hours
- \$5.00 for 12 hours
- \$10.00 for 24 hours



PARKING PAY STATION INFORMATION: Upon entering the ramp, park your vehicle and immediately visit one of the pay stations located in each ramp. Please estimate your stay and pay for your parking time accordingly. Things to note regarding the ramps is that parking enforcement is 24/7 (the citation for not paying at a pay station is \$30); pay stations accept credit cards, debit cards and cash; pay stations do not give change and pay stations do not give refunds. It is NOT necessary to display the printed receipt for payment in your vehicle. An alternate to paying at the pay station is the Parkmobile App.



PARKMOBILE APP: The City of Davenport offers a “Skip the line” feature that allows patrons of the parking ramps to download a mobile application (Parkmobile) to take advantage of paying for parking online. The Parkmobile Zone Numbers are 9692 for the RiverCenter Ramp, 9690 for the Harrison Ramp and 9691 for the Redstone Ramp. Parkmobile allows you to pay for parking with your phone, save time going back to the pay station (extend your parking time from the app), and optional notifications to alert you when your paid parking will expire. There is a \$0.30 fee associated with the application for each transaction.

***Failure to pre-pay for parking could result in an unavoidable \$30 parking citation.**
